

Heavy or voluminous baggage

Domestic flights

AIR TAHITI

Please note that surfboards are only accepted under 1,80m long, only on ATR flights and availability permitting.

Any voluminous baggage exceeding 1,80m must be presented to the freight department. This service closes 120 minutes before each departure. We recommend travellers to come to the check in counter 3 hours before to drop their package and have a direct confirmation. We can not guarantee in advance the booking and the availability of freight on the requested day. It is possible that your package does not travel on the same flight than you.

International flights

AIR TAHITI NUI

Air Tahiti Nui allows you to register for free, in addition to your franchise, a surfboard, body board, longboard, kite-surf, or paddle of 23 Kg and 250 cm long maximum.

AIR FRANCE

Prior approval of Air France Customer Service is required. The request must be made no later than 48 hours before the departure of your international flight. Your surf board is considered as a standard hold baggage if its size is less than 300 cm and its weight is 23 kg. His transport is included free of charge in the price of your air ticket and if it is the only piece of luggage that you entrust to us (or one of the 2 cabin baggage if you travel in Business or First class.

For each airline company, we recommend to go ahead for any information or reservation of sports equipment. Please note that each company has its own respective conditions.

INFORMATIONS

MEANS OF TRANSPORT

AVIS - Rental car

Car racks are available for rent only on vehicles of category B (Economy), C (Compact), D (Intermediate), and F (Compact automatic). For the installation of racks the price is 500xpf.

For renting racks:

- From 1 to 7 days of rental, the rate is 1500xpf / day.
- For rental of more than 7 days, package of 10 500xpf / stay. Booking racks with the rental car, direct payment at the AVIS counter.

TAXI

Taxi fare:

- 1000xpf cover + 130xpf / km + 500xpf (for voluminous baggage: surfboards etc)
- 100xpf / baggage (medium or large suitcases)

Please note that not all taxis are equipped for transporting surfboards. We recommend requesting a quote from the taxi specifying the number of people, the presence and the number of surf boards before getting into the vehicle.
